RELEASE SUMMARY

Release 6.1 for SBC 1000 and SBC 2000 is an exciting new offering with even greater value for the enterprise. Building on the superior quality and performance of the current platform, Sonus is delivering lower total cost of ownership (TCO) through expanded standard port density, higher capacity, and increased capability – all at lower price points. The award-winning Sonus SBC 1000 and SBC 2000 are designed to facilitate a simple, flexible transition to Skype for Business for enterprises, and Release 6.1 enhances that value proposition by delivering the following new features:

- <u>Sonus Cloud Link</u> saves customers costs associated with server hardware and implementation for Microsoft Cloud Connector Edition and Office 365 Cloud PBX.
- <u>New general purpose applications solutions module (ASM)</u> increases SBC 1000 SBA capacity to 1000 users and 240 calls, and allows on-board hosting of third-party applications for both SBC 1000 and SBC 2000 through the inclusion of two Microsoft Hyper-V virtual machines.
- <u>SBC 1000 performance and capacity improvements</u> including a 20% increase in supported SBC sessions, doubling the available PRI ports and allowing for more legacy port configuration options.
- <u>New SBC 1000 gateway configurations</u> are lower priced configurations that provide an enterprise accessible platform when a gateway is all that is necessary. Should the enterprise needs change, and more capability is required, these units can be upgraded to add SBC functionality through application of a license.

Sonus Cloud Link integrates Microsoft's Skype for Business Cloud Connector Edition with Sonus' SBC 1000 and SBC 2000 into a single appliance, enabling enterprises to rapidly and securely provision Cloud Connector Edition with Cloud PBX in Office 365 at scale, while maintaining local PSTN connectivity and legacy infrastructure.

• Unmatched Scalability and Capacity in an Integrated Solution.

The Sonus Cloud Link appliance scales up to a maximum of 500 concurrent Cloud PBX calls. By providing industry-leading scalability on a single device, enterprise customers are able to reduce TCO and minimize the number of appliances needed for capacity purposes.

• Simple Deployment with Reduced Installation Times. The Sonus Cloud Link appliance utilizes an easy-to-use GUI that reduces installation times from more than a day to as little as one hour. Designed by Sonus with input from expert consultants, the GUI speeds configuration through "one-click" online context-based help, simple import and export of security certificates, grouping frequent operations under single headings, and configuration wizards for common interworking settings. This flexibility rapidly accelerates enterprise provisioning of Cloud Connector Edition with Cloud PBX in Office 365 by up to 90 percent.

• Security from Denial of Service (DoS) Attacks.

The Sonus Cloud Link appliance was designed to withstand malicious activity under normal operation, securing the enterprise network border against unauthorized intrusion attacks, including DoS and DDoS. During attacks, Sonus Cloud Link maintains connected calls, allows for additional calls to be placed, and remains operational with all monitoring, reporting, and configuration capabilities fully accessible.

Sonus SBC Edge with New Applications Solutions Module (ASM) Details

The award-winning Sonus SBC 1000 and SBC 2000 now features a new ASM (or embedded single board computer) based on an Intel[®] Pentium[®] dual-core processor (leveraging the Broadwell Server CPU family) that increases the number of Skype for Business SBA (Survivable Branch Appliance) users on the SBC 1000 from 400 to 1000, and the number of SBA calls from 100 to 240. The result means enterprises can dramatically reduce their CAPEX and OPEX costs as they deploy the SBC 1000 into larger branch offices requiring SBA features.

Additionally, the new ASM comes standard with Windows Server 2012 and two Hyper-V virtual machines to allow on-board hosting of third-party applications on both the SBC 1000 and SBC 2000. This capability allows enterprises to save CAPEX costs associated with servers that would otherwise be required to host third-party applications.

Sonus SBC 1000 with Performance and Capacity Improvements

The Sonus SBC 1000 with Release 6.1 presents a number of port and capacity improvements to help enterprises lower CAPEX and OPEX costs as capacity and throughput rises in branch office deployments:

- Additional DSP resources to support a maximum of 192 SIP sessions, a 20% increase over previous releases, to increase supported SIP client and trunking capabilities.
- A doubling of supported PRI ports (2 ports to 4), to address large branch office sites with up to 4 PRI legacy connections to on-site PBXs and/or PSTN connections.
- A tripling of FXO ports (4 ports to 12) to address branch offices with significant #'s of fax machines and legacy handsets.
- An additional Ethernet port (from 2 ports to 3) provides a backup WAN connection without the use of complex VLANs and without the additional costs associated with VLAN-aware upstream routers.

NEW Sonus SBC 1000 Gateway Offering

The Sonus SBC 1000 with Release 6.1 introduces new low-cost gateway configurations to address enterprise premise PRI/BRI "off-load" deployment scenarios. Such scenarios often do not require features such as SIP-to-SIP calling with transcoding, AD integration, or call forking. However, should customer requirements evolve, the Sonus gateway products may be upgraded to enable these features with a software license add-on that may be applied remotely.

Sonus will withdraw the pre-6.1 product from the market place according to the practice identified in the Sonus End of Product Sale policy posted on the Sonus web portal. Sonus will identify comparable 6.1 product as replacement to the pre-6.1 product when the withdrawal is announced.		
Are the new Release 6.1 SKUs priced higher than the SKUs currently for sale?	Yes. However, the 6.1 product presents a number of features not found in the pre-6.1 product, such as higher capacity and port expansion options, support of 3 rd party applications, etc. Furthermore, please note the 6.1 product is priced equal to or less than the comparable pre-6.1 product prior to the pricing actions identified in the document.		
Do the new Release 6.1 SKUs do everything that the SKUs currently for sale do?	 Yes, and much more. Note the following additional features on the comparable 6.1 products: SBC 1000 ability to support 192 SIP – SIP sessions, vs. 160 in pre-6.1 products; SBC 1000 ability to support 4 PRI ports, vs. 2 in pre-6.1 products; SBC 1000 available 3 GbE ports, vs. 2 in pre-6.1 products; SBC 1000 ability to support 12 FXO ports in FXx only configurations, vs. 4 in pre-6.1 products; SBC 1000 ASM (applications solutions module) with support for 1000 SBA (Microsoft® Skype for Business Survivable Branch Appliance) users/240 sessions, vs. 400 users/100 sessions in pre-6.1 products; SBC 1000/2000 ASM with Hyper-V support for 3rd party applications.
